The best way to do the movement of boats in containers is for each state to have a champion who can be the organiser of the container. I can liaise with this person regarding the rates and charges for the transportation of the containers . For example I am doing the organising here in WA for our container that is going to Brisbane at Christmas time.

Each state contact point or Association will need to find out how many boats intending travel the are to to Championships and then we'll need to work out what size container is required.
